ARTIST STATEMENT:

Being a painter by training, I use the loom to weave wool tapestries – paintings in fiber. The weavings rely on compositions of harmony, proportion, balance, and above all the visual music of color. Brilliant primary color itself is the subject of the artwork – color is king.

As early as I can remember, I was drawn to art and especially color. This led me to study at the Art Institute of Chicago, from which I graduated with a major in painting, never suspecting that weaving would eventually become my medium of choice.

I came to weaving through the serendipity of discovering a beautiful old barn loom in New Hampshire, just before moving to Maine in 1978. It opened the door to this iconic medium which has held me in its thrall for over four decades. My work is now done on a treasured vertical Finnish Varpapuu tapestry loom, around which my life and home in Maine revolve.

The process from design to completion brings me great joy. I begin each tapestry in a series with a focused design process and continue working with multiple colors until I feel I have exhausted the color design possibilities. Each new tapestry in a series is influenced by and builds upon the previous one. The audacious, brilliant Hunter Orange became my muse for a recent series that resulted in 19 pieces.

I beat the weft down by hand with a hardwood fork and with my fingers, using small butterfly hanks of yarn. Time consuming, this procedure requires concentration and patience; but, when taken from the loom, the piece is tight as a drum and the total, each single pick, is fully known.

Many of my early weavings referenced the landscapes and seascapes I found in Maine. The tapestries evolved gradually from horizontal to include the vertical, and more recently the tapestries have become more introspective. I have been simplifying my compositions, and my color palette has become increasingly bright and bold as my sight has become compromised.

It is said, "Your eyes are the window to your soul." I believe these works of art are the window to my soul. The creation of art is an act of faith. It proclaims – We are here. We were here. We mattered, we matter!
